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#### 1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY (OA)

The Organizing Authority is Gamla Stans Yacht Sällskap (GSYS)

#### 2. VENUE

The regatta will be sailed on the waters of the Stockholm city center in the vicinity of the Royal Castle and the historical naval island Kastellholmen. The club facilities at the Nya Djurgårdsvarvet (Beckholmsvägen 4), Royal Djurgården, are the shore base for the event.

#### 3. EVENT GRADING

#### 5. SKIPPERS AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

5.1 A small number of selected clubs are invited to the STOCKHOLM INTERNATIONAL TEAM RACE REGATTA 2022, an international event for two-boat team racing. The race will be sailed in J80 boats with four sailors per boat.

5.2 The registered skippers shall helm the boat at all times while racing, except in an emergency.

5.3 A team shall comprise eight persons, who shall sail together in two boats.

5.4 Any change of the crew can be done without permission until registration at the Race Office.

5.5 All sailors must be amatures or defined by the Group 1 of the World Sailing Classification code. Teams can apply for an exemption if a sailors profession would have no or little impact on the contest outcome. An exemption needs a written permission of the Organizing Authority.



#### 6. ENTRIES

#### 6.1 Entering

The skipper/team shall be entered on completion of registration and the payment of all fees and deposits. The closing date for the entry of a team is February 28th 2022. Entry shall be made by e-mail to: raceoffice@gsys.nu

#### 6.2 Entry Fee

A non-refundable entry fee of Swedish Crowns Twenty Nine Thousand (SEK 29.000). The entry fee of Swedish Crowns (SEK) 29.000 shall be paid to;

The entry fee includes the cost of use of the boats throughout the regatta including the practice day and lunch package each racing day. Furthermore, social events according to appendix A for the eight-team members are included.

Please, send a confirmation of your payment to <a href="mailto:raceoffice@gsys.nu">raceoffice@gsys.nu</a> who also can assist in case of questions concerning the entry. A confirmation of the receipt of the entry and the entry fee will be sent out by the Race Office.

Communication between the Organizing Authority and participants will be conducted by email through <a href="mailto:raceoffice@gsys.nu">raceoffice@gsys.nu</a>. Each team when entering must provide the OA with an e-mail address and mobile number

#### 6.3 Damage deposit

A) Before going afloat for the first time each team shall agree in writing to be charged for the damage incurred via invoice if the situation arises. Maximum amount SEK 5,000 per boat and incident. A specification of damage charges will be attached to the SI. Additionally before going afloat for the first time in a boat provided by the OA, every competitor shall lodge with the OA a signed

Sailing Agreement.

- B) This deposit is the maximum payable by the skipper as a result of any one incident.
- C) If a deduction from the damage deposit is decided by the OA, it may require that the deposit be restored to its original amount before the skipper will be permitted to continue in the event.
- **D)** Any remaining deposit after the event will be refunded within 10 days after the event.
- **6.4** Insurance All competitors are required to have adequate third party insurance.

#### 7. RULES

- 7.1 The event will be governed by the rules as de fined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the Appendix D, Team Racing Rules.
- 7.2 Class rules shall not apply.
- 7.3 Races will be umpired.
- 7.4 Right of appeal will be denied in accordance with rule 70.5(a).
- 7.5 Penalties imposed by umpires shall be One-Turn Penalties rather than Two-Turns Penalties. This changes RRS D2.
- 7.6 RRS 40 shall apply at all times without the display of Flag Y. The PFD shall be a minimum of 50N. The OA will not be able to provide PFDs and it is the responsibility of each competitor to have one. The participants shall be aware that the water is cold even if the weather is nice.
- 7.7 Any alteration of the SI and decisions taken by the OA and its organization will be posted before 0900 each race day on the Official Notice Board at Djurgårdsvarvet. However the Sailing Instructions will contain a provision allowing for further changes to be notified to competitors on the water during the day race committee or the umpires.



#### 8. BOATS AND SAILS

- **8.1** The event will be sailed in J80 boats.
- 8.3 The following sails will be provided for each boat: Mainsail, Genoa.
- 8.4 Boats will be allocated by draw, either daily or for each round as decided by the race committee.

#### 9. CREW (INCLUDING SKIPPER)

- 9.1 The number of crew (including the skippers) shall be Eight (8). All registered crew shall sail all races.
- 9.2 When a registered skipper is unable to continue in the event the OA may authorize an original crew member to substitute.
- 9.5 When a registered crew member is unable to continue in the event the OA may authorize a substitute, a temporary substitute or other adjustment.

## 10. RACE FORMAT AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 10.1 The planned format is one or more Round Robins, which May be followed by a Semi Final, Final, Petit Final and a race for fifth place, time permitting.
- 10.2 The format and number of races will be described in the Sailing Instructions and at the Skippers Briefing.
- 10.3 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and will also be presented on the website not later than three weeks before the start of the event.

#### 11. COURSE

- **11.1** The course will be windward/leeward with starboard roundings, finishing downwind.
- **11.2** Furthermore, the participants should be especially aware that the racing will be held in

the center of Stockholm, through a special permission by the Stockholm Port Authorities. We can, therefore, offer an exciting racing event right in the center of the Capital of Sweden, which will be a unique event in the world. The participants shall, however, take into consideration the commercial and non commercial boat traffic around and also partly in the race course, which creates an extra element of sailing skill and risks involved. Commercial vessels have the right of way.

#### 12. ADVERTISING

- 12.1 As boats and equipment will be supplied by the Organizing Authority, World Sailing regulation 20.4 applies. Each boat will be required to display advertising as supplied by the OA.
- **12.1** As boats are supplied by the competitors the advertising category of the Class will apply.

#### 13. PRIZES

- 13.1 The prize giving ceremony will be held after the races on Sunday afternoon at the yacht club.
- 13.2 The winning team will be awarded the GSYS Team Race Cup. Other prizes will be awarded.

#### 14. ACCOMMODATION, TRANSPORTATION

- 15.1 In case the event will be canceled due to Covid-19 restrictions, the Entry Fee will be repaid in full.
- 15.2 All participants must be able to show a valid Covid Pass upon registration and any other document required by the Swedish Health authorities at the time of the regatta.
